

With more time, you can do any of the half-day suggestions and add in a ranger program, flight tour, land tour, or, if physically active, a hike. You might, for example, view the "Grand Canyon: The Hidden Secrets" IMAX film, do a fly-over, and then take a vigorous hike or a leisurely rim walk.

Explore the canyon with National Geographic Expeditions. Four to five hour naturalist guided tours depart daily at the National Geographic Visitor Center. 888-355-0550.

Two days or more

With the luxury of time, you can mix any of the above activities with the suggestion at right. Make inquiries early in the day for last-minute openings. You might consider day hiking into the canyon along Bright Angel or South Kaibab trails. Kids 4 to 14 can sign up for Junior Ranger Programs. The Grand Canyon Field Institute offers one- to eight-day classes and field trips.

Land Tours by ATV, Jeep, or Horse Reserve at National Geographic Visitor Center and Bright Angel Lodge. Learn about the flora and fauna of the Kaibab National Forest.

Physically Active Hikes

- Bright Angel Trail to Indian Garden During non-summer months, you can go to Plateau Point for a view of the river.
- South Kaibab Trail to Cedar Ridge 3-mile round trip.

Camping at Indian Garden or Bright Angel Campground Booked months in advance. Ask about daily openings at the National Geographic Visitor Center or Backcountry Information Center.

Phantom Ranch
Ask at the National Geographic Visitor Center about reservations. Make bookings at Bright Angel Lodge.

- Visit Tusayan Ruins near East Entrance 3-hour round trip.
- Drive to North Rim 8-hour round trip; open only in summer months
