## EXPECT THE UNEXPECTED

**GOOD EATS, HISTORIC TOWNS, EPIC LAKE DAYS AND ALL THE GREAT COFFEE YOU COULD HOPE FOR**—Reno Tahoe satisfies in so many ways. The surprises are particularly memorable. Reno is the closest city to Burning Man and the **Playa Art Park** is a collection of sculptures from past years. A climb on the heart sculpture is a favorite. **Bundox Boccee** is a huge indoor fun zone of Bocce courts, shuffleboard, Skee-ball and special events. If you're a history buff, take the 35-minute drive from Reno to **Virginia City**. The town dates back to the discovery of silver here in the 1860s, and is full of Victorian-style buildings, historic sites and museums. A steam train makes 35-minute round trips to historic Gold Hill. You may think you know food trucks, but **Food Truck Friday** in Reno is MASSIVE, stretching the length of Idlewild Park on Fridays, 4–9 p.m. from May to September. **Hub Coffee Roasters** is in a cute neighborhood along a tree-lined path on the Truckee River. It has all the beautifully-crafted lattes and chocolate croissants you could ever want, plus big picture windows and an impressive outdoor patio.

## PHOTOGENIC ADVENTURES

**ALPENGLow. SUNSETS. COTTON CANDY CLOUDS. THE MILKY WAY.** Reno Tahoe skies constantly serve up an irresistible light show, no matter the season or time of day. Lake Tahoe is a delight to the eye and all the senses. Take a sailboat charter to the middle of “Big Blue,” or take in the view along the new bike path to **Sand Harbor State Park**. If you want a bit more exercise, Monkey Rock is a popular 2.5-mile round-trip climb to a spectacular vantage point. With more than 300 days of sunshine, exploring Reno on foot or by bike is an option almost

all year. The Truckee River makes its way through downtown, bringing nature to the city’s heart. Take a stroll through the **Riverwalk District** to find coffee shops, picnic-perfect parks and plenty of photo ops. Get outside the city limits and experience all the desert has to offer, from wild horses and diverse wildlife to striking rock formations. There are **off-road routes** surrounding Reno Tahoe, so put it in 4WD, roll down the windows and explore the great wide open.



## 72 HOURS IN RENO TAHOE


**RENO TAHOE BRIMS WITH A SENSE THAT NOW IS ITS TIME**—a combination of unparalleled natural beauty, Burning Man-fueled arts community, and a Wild-West-meets-Tesla entrepreneurial grit. New mountain bike trails appear almost as quickly as new restaurants. Hotel exteriors are converted into the tallest climbing wall in the world. A downtown stretch of the Truckee River becomes a whitewater park. Spend your morning skiing at 10,000' and your afternoon climbing Pig Rock near the Black Rock Desert. Shows and gaming might be a priority for your three days in Reno, but if you fancy a quick

break and light exercise, scenic hiking trails are just outside the city at **Hidden Valley and Galena Creek regional parks**. Visiting Lake Tahoe is a must for many visitors. Or, start the morning just steps from a downtown Reno hotel room **fly-fishing the Truckee River**. Go paddleboarding on the calm water at **Sparks Marina**, a great spot to catch sunset over the Sierra Nevada mountains. Then close down the lanes at **Reno Axe!** Sign a waiver; order a drink; throw an axe. Between it all, eat, drink and repeat through the city's array of unique dining spots, brew pubs and coffee roasters.

## WINTER PARADISE

**RENO TAHOE HAS THE LARGEST CONCENTRATION OF SKI RESORTS IN NORTH AMERICA** and is home to world-class resorts like Squaw Valley, who hosted the 1960 Winter Olympic Games, and family favorite Northstar California Resort. Less than an hour from Reno you can find Mt Rose Ski Tahoe, the region's highest base elevation resort, and Tahoe's hidden gem, Diamond Peak.

Winter here is ideal for cross-country and backcountry skiing, snowshoeing and snowmobiling. Or, take a glider ride over the Lake Tahoe's snowcapped mountains and incredibly blue waters!

Fall through spring, Reno and Carson valleys are usually

snow-free. With over 300 days of sunshine, the outdoor opportunities are endless. Rent a bike and cruise downtown Reno or along the Tahoe-Pyramid Bike Trail. Mountain bike trails near Reno and Carson Valley are ideal every month of the year. Tee up at one of our year-round golf courses where the greens fees are a steal deal, and warm up before tee time at Grand Bay Driving Range at Grand Sierra Resort.

Natural hot springs are found along the eastern slope of the Sierra Nevada range and out in the Black Rock Desert. Winter off-roading is often possible in much of the high desert. When you've had your fill of the outdoors, cozy cafes, fun bars and candlelight dinners await!





Run by a young beer savant, **Lead Dog Brewing's** Reno or Sparks locations are must visits, featuring a rotating line up of eclectic flavors. Sharing a building with Lead Dog's Reno brew pub is **Basin and Range Cellars**, Nevada's only estate winery. For premium IPA, New

England-style beer shakes and hop bombs, visit **Revision Brewing Co.** Their beer factory in Sparks is the largest in the region, or visit their low-key taproom above **Pignic Pub & Patio** in downtown Reno. Cocktails anyone? Compare 18th century-styled spirits of **Seven Troughs Distilling** to the modern perfectionism of **10 Torr Distillery and Brewery**. Seven Troughs produces small batch moonshine and whiskey in

open barrels while 10 Torr creates smooth spirits and canned cocktails on a large-scale. **Bently Heritage Estate Distillery**, in the Carson Valley, grow their own grains to produce gins, vodkas and liqueurs. **Frey Ranch Estate Distillery** in Fallon has roots dating back more than a 100-years, offering absinthe, vodka, gin and bourbon.




## CHOW DOWN
